SMEs include business units that provide the largest contribution in Sidoarjo both in terms of regional income and labor. Competitive strategy needs to be done in order to increase consumer appeal when visiting Tanggulangin to enjoy the unique handicraft products of Tanggulangin Sidoarjo. The purpose of this study are (1) To know competitive strategies undertaken by SMEs in Tanggulangin Sidoarjo (2) Knowing barriers to obstacles in the face of competition. This research uses descriptive qualitative approach. Technique of collecting survey data, interview and documentation and Focus Group Pacussion FGD, while Method of analysis using Data Triangulation and Milles Hebermand method (data collection, data reduction, data display and conclusion).
